

## SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

## **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- 1. The applicant's parents must be a CURRENT dues-paying member of the Johnson County Farm Bureau Federation. Applicants 24 years of age and older must have their own membership. Just having Farm Bureau insurance does not meet the qualifications. The name and money for dues must be received in the county insurance office 45 days before the application is received in order to qualify.
- 2. The applicant must be graduating in the current year's class when the application is submitted or be a continuing college student.
- 3. The applicant must be enrolled at a Community College, University or Vocational School at the time the scholarship is granted.
- **4.** A letter specifically applying for this scholarship and an application form accompanied by a grade transcript must be postmarked or delivered by **April 1**, to the Farm Bureau Financial Insurance Office, 44 South Lobban, Buffalo, WY or mailed to Farm Bureau Scholarship at 3501 Us Hwy 14-16 E, Clearmont, Wy 82835

## **SELECTION OF RECIPIENT:**

The selection will be made after April 1 of each year. The recipient will be notified by April 15<sup>th</sup>.

The scholarship will be \$500.00 for the school year. \$250.00 will be given each semester. The check will be made payable to the recipient and the college, university or school that the student will be attending. The money will be available during registration each semester.

The following guidelines are established:

- 1. The selection will be on a deserving basis, however, the recipient must have at least a 2.5 scholastic grade point average based upon a 4.0 scale.
- 2. No one will be disqualified because of sex, race, color, creed, or religious beliefs.
