

# 2024 AG BOOKS FOR KIDS Poster Contest

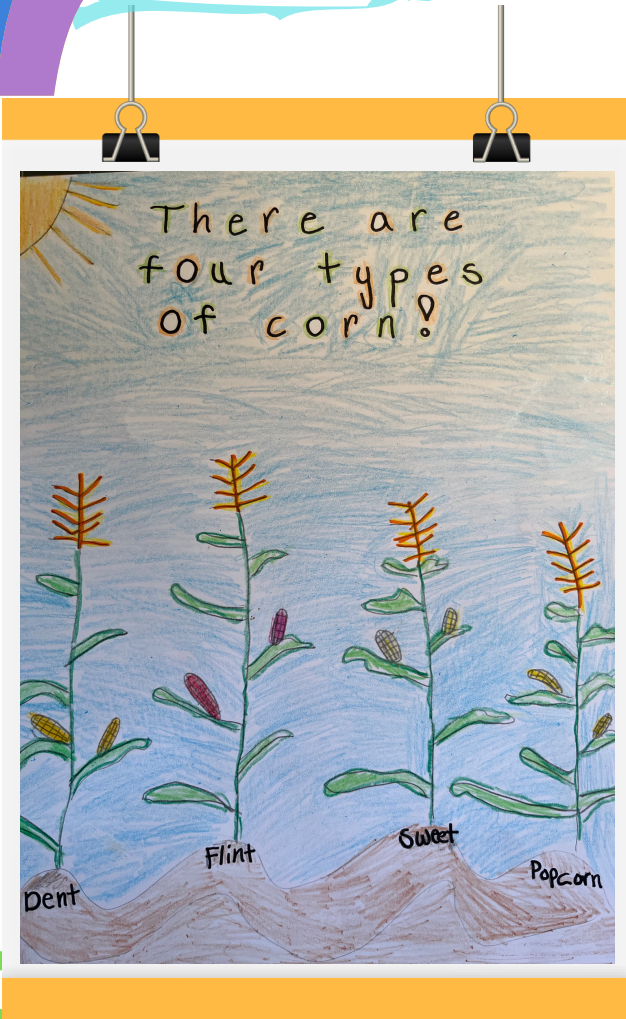

3. Draw and color a picture of the favorite thing you learned about agriculture from the book. Optional: you may use UP TO FIFTEEN (15) WRITTEN WORDS to describe your poster. Use fine line black marker or similar instrument to highlight text.
4. **Size: 8 1/2 x 11" paper (poster type/cardstock preferred)**
5. Painted, pencils, crayons or markers
6. On the back please include: student's name; grade; age; teacher's name; county; school's name; address and phone number.
7. Entry deadline is March 29, 2024

8. **Your county Farm Bureau Federation representative will make arrangements to pick up the entries for judging locally.**
