



2026 Scholarship Qualifications

\$500 -\$1500 Scholarships from the Natrona County Farm & Ranch Bureau

Qualifications:

1. Must be a current member or have an immediate family member (parent or guardian) who is a current member of our county Farm Bureau Federation.
• Having an insurance policy with Mountain West Farm Bureau Mutual Insurance Company DOES NOT QUALIFY as a membership.
2. Applicant must be a Wyoming high school graduate.
3. Applicant must be enrolled at a Wyoming accredited school. Proof of enrollment status is required prior to scholarship disbursement.
4. Applicant must be Freshman or Sophomore level in higher education.
5. Scholarship selection will be on a deserving basis; however, the winner must have at least a 2.5 scholastic grade point average based upon a 4.0 scale.
6. Applications must be accompanied by all required documentation as noted on the application form.
7. Applications must be post marked by May 10th or emailed by May 15th. Mail applications to: N.C. Farm & Ranch Bureau Federation, 301 Thelma Drive PMB #535, Casper, Wyoming 82609. Email applications to: n.c.farmandranchbureau@gmail.com.
8. No one will be disqualified by sex, race, color, creed, or religious beliefs.

Required Application Attachments - (Applications will be disqualified if received without the below items):

1. A recent 2" X 3" or larger photograph of just the applicant
2. A transcript or grade report of your two most recent semester grades.
3. At least one (1) letter of recommendation that describes your ability, character, and financial need. Recommendations may come from any of the following categories:
 - a. Farm Bureau Federation Leader
 - b. Farm Bureau Federation Member
 - c. Farm Bureau Insurance Agent
 - d. School Teacher or School Administrator

- e. Community Leader
- f. Church Leader
- g. Employer

Selection Process:

- The Scholarship Committee will begin the selection process after May 15th. Applicants will be notified as soon as possible thereafter.
- The presentation of the award will be made by mail in the form of a check, made payable to the school of applicant winner on behalf of scholarship recipient.
- The check will be issued upon the timely receipt of verification of enrollment from the scholarship recipient.
 - o Enrollment verification must be received by the scholarship committee by October 1st of the application year. If the scholarship recipient fails to submit proof of enrollment by October 1st, scholarship will be awarded to an alternate applicant.
